- Negotiation and execution of both Gas and Chemical Spot Charter, Time Charters and CoAs.
- Collaborate on a daily basis within the global Chartering team for cross-regional cargoes, and exchange global

- Work together with the team to review laytime calculations and be responsible for the company's demurrage exposure within the region.
